

PROPER DISPOSAL OF PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS

To properly dispose of unused medications, place them in a Safe Homes Coalition resealable bag or ziplock bag and bring them to a community-based medication disposal location. To find the nearest location, please visit makeitasafehome.org.

Be sure to follow the disposal directions you received with your medicines or ask a healthcare professional or pharmacist about disposal.

DO NOT flush your prescription medications. These will end up in our waterways and the sewage systems cannot remove these medications from water that is released into lakes, rivers or oceans.
